


Welcome!

Desktop Version


Step 1

Navigate to your Profile. Select Settings.



Step 2

Scroll down to Multi-Factor Authentication.



Step 3


Toggle on Multi-Factor Authentication.

User will be logged out. Upon logging back in, enter email and password.

Step 5


Follow the steps to set up the authentication factor of your preference – text, phone, or authenticator app.



Mobile App Version


Step 1

Navigate to your Profile by clicking Profile in the lower menu bar. Select General.




Step 2

Select Multi-Factor Authentication.



Step 3

Toggle on Multi-Factor Authentication to on. This will enable MFA on your account.



Step 4

Once the setting is selected, you will be logged out. Upon logging back in, enter email and password.

Step 5

Follow the steps to set up the authentication factor of your preference – text, phone, or authenticator app.
