

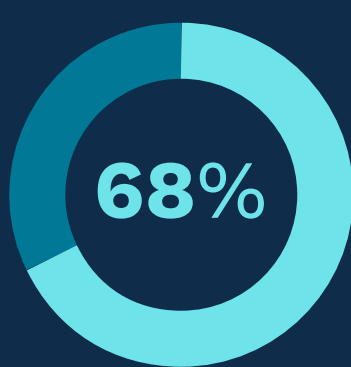
These 8 Stats Reveal the Future of K-12 Payments

have a strong desire to go cashless in the near future

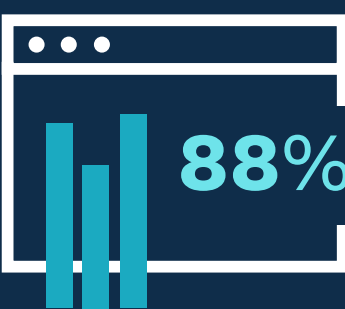

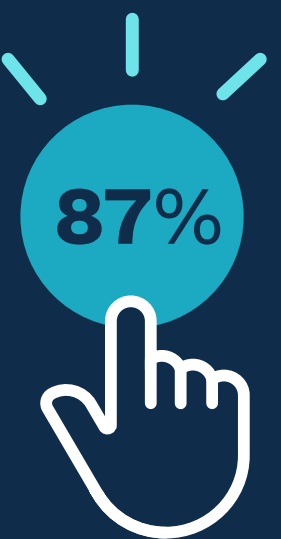

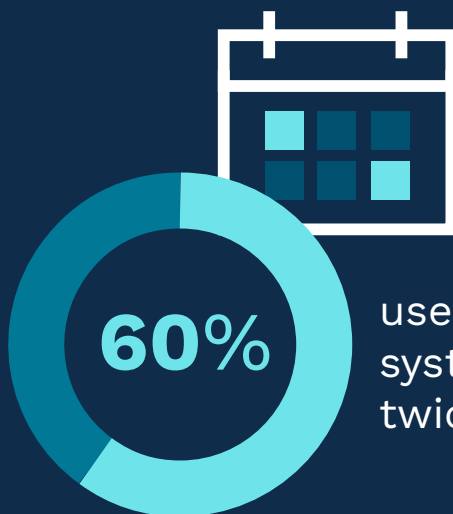
